Gateway is the fastest growing and second largest of the 12 Connecticut Community Colleges, Gateway offers over 90 accredited academic programs that lead to associate degrees or certificates.

Approximately 80% of the students who attend Gateway Community College remain in the region, generating \$389 million back into the local economy annually.

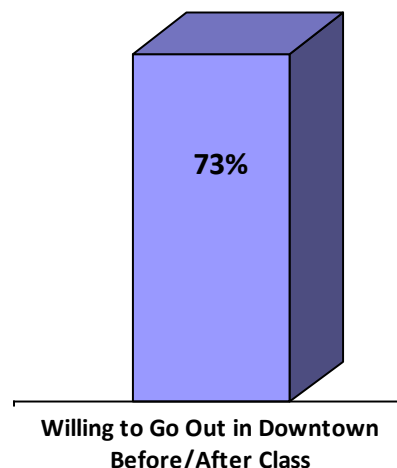

STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS

- More female than male students (59% Female and 41% Male)
- Average age of a student is 28
- 45% White, 22% African-America, 18% Latino, 3% Asian and 16% Other
- Of the student population, 34% are enrolled full-time and 66% part-time
- Of all the registered seats, 69% are during the day and 31% in the evening
